**004. Reports :**

**A. Sports President :** Organising kit, Inter Varsity Day and the Sports Fair over the Summer. Attended meetings regarding the new sports centre over the summer. Liz Kerr has been replaced at the CSR by Tom Miller. **B. CSR :** Graham McDougall has been awarded Order of Merit at SUS Golf. New building is currently at Stage C, moving towards Stage D. There is a presentation available on the new sports Centre. Please contact SDSO, Sports President or Leanne should you wish to view. New centre will contain 3 squash courts with moveable walls. The University has asked the CSR to come up with a business plan to ensure there are contributions towards the costs. A new CSR

membership system has been installed, although there are on going issues with it. There will be various new classes on offer at CSR. Weigh equipment has been replaced. More will arrive within the next 2 – 3 weeks. An extra fitness instruction has been employed for the gym. Bursary and Golf applications close soon. Clubs to make their elite athletes aware of this.
